The Association is a non-profit-making body whose aim is to provide a sound primary education in English. It is intended especially to cater for the needs of temporary residents in Perak whose children are likely to complete their schooling within the British system, & to offer an environment which will enable a child to make the eventual transfer fairly easily to a preparatory or junior school. We also welcome Malaysian children whose parents wish them to have an initial grounding in English.

Great importance is naturally attached to a thorough training in the "three Rs" & to the development of manual & physical dexterity through handicrafts, physical training & dancing. History, Geography, etc. form part of the curriculum, which is designed to widen the child's cultural horizon, stimulate curiosity & steadily encourage the reading habit.

The House system is a significant feature of school life, & children are encouraged to take pride in working well as a contribution to their house.

The newly-adapted premises at 14, Tiger Lane are light & spacious; the large garden serves not only as a playground but occasionally as an outdoor classroom.

As far as possible staffing appointments are made with the objects both of maintaining a high standard of qualified instruction & of keeping class numbers small.

FEES

\$200 per term for a child under the age of seven on the first day of term; & **\$225** for a child of seven & over.

A reduction of **\$20** per term will be made for each child when two or more children from the same family are attending the School.

One month's notice to withdraw a child is required, in writing, or payment of fees in lieu of such notice.

Accounts for fees will be issued by the Hon. Secretary & cheques in payment of fees should be sent to the Hon. Secretary, The Tenby School Association, c/o P. O. Box 136, Ipoh.

Each child is also required to bring & keep at school a pair of white canvas shoes & a shoe bag.

Brown hair bands are permitted, but not other coloured hair bands or jewellery.

COLLECTION OF CHILDREN

Parents with two or more children to collect from different classes should come at the latest time concerned. Children from Classes I & II who have to wait will remain in school under supervision.

Cars should wait on the verge **OUTSIDE** the school gates & parents or syces are requested to walk to the front door of the school to collect their children.

AFTERNOON SCHOOL

Tuesdays **2 p.m. — 3.30 p.m.**

Thursdays **2 p.m. — 3.30 p.m.**

This is for children already seven, or who will be seven during the course of the term. On these days any child who so wishes can bring a packed luncheon & remain at school during the midday interval. A member of staff will be on duty.

MID-MORNING BREAK

Children may bring their own drink & biscuit. Milk from Cold Storage (various flavours) will be available at school. This will cost **14 cents** per 1/3rd pint bottle & parents will be billed at the end of term. Orders for milk must be placed with the Principal on the first day of each term.

HOMEWORK

Parents are requested to see that children complete any homework given & to consult with the class teacher if any difficulties arise. Children who for some reason are unable to do their homework should bring a note to their class teacher. A note should also be brought after any absence from school.

NOTE. Times, classes etc., are liable to alteration according to circumstances, of which due notice will be given.
