THE TENBY SCHOOL ASSOCIATION

The Association is a non-profit making body whose aim is to provide a sound primary education in English. It is intended especially to cater for the needs of non-Malaysian children, and to offer an environment which will enable the child to make the eventual transfer to a preparatory or junior school in their own country. We also welcome Malaysian children, under the age of six, whose parents wish them to have an initial grounding in English.

Great importance is naturally attached to a thorough understanding of the "three R's", and to the development of manual and physical dexterity through handicrafts, physical education, music and drama. History, Geography and Nature Study etc. form part of the curriculum, which is designed to widen the child's cultural horizon, stimulate curiosity and steadily encourage the reading habit.

The House system is a significant feature of school life, and children are encouraged to take pride in working well as a contribution to their house.

The premises are light and spacious; the large garden serves not only as a playground but occasionally as an outdoor classroom.

As far as possible staffing appointments are made with the objects both of maintaining a high standard of qualified instruction and of keeping class numbers small.

ADMISSION

Applications should be made to the Principal. Admissions are subject to place availability.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

One month's notice to withdraw a child is required, in writing, or payment of fees in lieu of such notice.

UNIFORM

This consists of :—

BOYS White shirts and fawn shorts.

GIRLS Yellow and white check dresses.

Shoes should be brown and socks white.

Each child is also required to bring and keep at school a pair of white canvas shoes and a shoe bag.

Yellow hair bands are permitted, but not other coloured hair bands or jewellery.

COLLECTION OF CHILDREN

Parents with two or more children to collect from different classes should come at the latest time concerned. Children who have to wait will remain in school under supervision. If parents are unable to collect their children due to unforeseen circumstances, they should telephone and advise the school of the delay.

MID-MORNING BREAK

Orange Juice and Biscuits are provided for all the children during the mid-morning break.

AFTERNOON SCHOOL

Tuesdays	2 p.m.	—	3.30 p.m.
Thursdays	2 p.m.	—	3.30 p.m.

On these days any child over the age of seven, who so wishes can bring a packed luncheon and remain at school during the mid-day interval. A member of staff will be on duty.

HOMEWORK

Parents are requested to see that children complete any homework given and to consult the class teacher if any difficulties arise. Children who for some reason are unable to do their homework should bring a note to their class teacher. A note should also be brought after any absence from school.

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

The School will close for all public holidays.

OPTIONAL HOLIDAYS

Four optional holidays will be taken during the year at the discretion of the Principal.

NOTE. Times, classes etc. are liable to alteration according to circumstances, of which due notice will be given.
