Caving enthusiasts and adventure seekers are up for an adrenaline rush! Gua Tempurung is a cave in Gopeng in the Kampar District of Perak. The total length of the cave is 4.5km although the parts accessible to visitors are about 1.9km. The cave even contains an underground river of 1.6km in length and comprises of five giant domes.

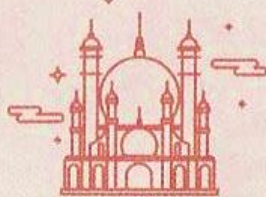

A HIDDEN TREASURE FOR ALL FANS OF HISTORY AND ANCIENT ARTIFACTS

Located in Kota Tampan, near Lenggong, this Archaeological Museum is a treasure trove of history, with its most famous display being that of Perak Man. Perak Man is the oldest human skeleton found in Peninsular Malaysia and dates back 10, 000 to 11, 000 years, from the Stone Age, right around the Paleolithic Era.
